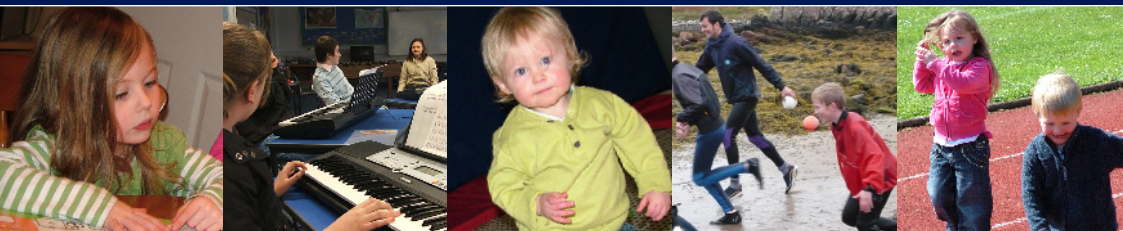

Following the success of the Child's Play events, LAYC (with the support of the Early Years Team in Children's and Families, City of Edinburgh Council) is running another all day Saturday programme of training aimed at those adults working in after school clubs, children's groups and play groups.

The courses are each stand alone and will run for 2 ½ hours. You can select only one course from the morning and/or one from the afternoon.

Places are restricted to a maximum of 2 places per group per course. Places must be booked in advance. Failure to notify LAYC of a cancellation of a place will result in a charge of £20 per course being made. Groups will be invoiced for the course fees after the event.

Certificates will be provided for participants as part of the LAYC Training Scheme on completion of a short course related exercise.

**TO GET THERE** Nelson Hall is at the corner of St Leonard's Street and Bernard Terrace. LRT buses 47, 37, 7, 31, 29, 3, 8, 49 to Clerk Street and get off around Bernard Terrace and walk along or Easi Parks have a car park at 62 St Leonard's Street (EH8 9SW) off the Pleasance and nearly across the road from the Centre. There is also limited pay and display street parking.
