



LAYC Training Scheme Using Arts & Crafts with Older Children



Introduction

Arts and Crafts projects can be cheap, easy to set up and fun for all ages. But how confident are you in thinking about how to have a great (and creative) time running arts and crafts activities for older children?

The course is aimed at sessional and volunteer youth and children's workers who are looking to use arts and crafts sessions in their work with older children (P6 and P7 ages).

Content

The course will be practice based and provide opportunities to sample basic arts and crafts ideas for older children.

The course is very practical with group activities, discussion and tutor input. Arts and Crafts can get a bit messy – so wear appropriate clothes.

Outcomes

By the end of the course participants will :

- Be able to follow a basic design and create an arts and crafts activity;
- Have had experience of participating in arts and crafts activities;
- Be able to run an arts and crafts activity for older children or young people.
